Glyph Icons

In addition to the writing system, Castithan makes use of a number of glyph icons that, by themselves, stand for entire words or concepts. These are used everywhere, including in formal texts—and, in fact, are more frequently used than the spelled-out versions of the words. All of these glyph icons are accessed by first pressing the equals sign (=), and then pressing a letter (usually something that will hopefully remind the user of the concept in question). A list of the glyph icons appears below:
