

## The New Votan Planet

*The new Votan planet formerly shared by the Indogene and the Castithans would likely have one or more names native to one or both of those languages. Below are some options. For each option there will be a romanized version, and a version in each native orthography. I've also provided a suggestion for how the name can be used (and pronounced) in plain English.*

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(1) *Ellasmik* (Indogene)

Etymology: Derives from the Indogene verb *ella*, and means "place of life".

English Variant: Ellasmik (E-las-mik)

Castithan: የኤላሱምዕክ (Elasumiko)

(2) *Duorabari* (Indogene)

Etymology: Derives from the Indogene noun *duora*, and means "the collected lands".

English Variant: Dworabari (DWO-ra-ba-ri)

Castithan: ፍወርባብ (Dworabari)

(3) *Gobenje* (Indogene)

Etymology: Derives from the Indogene noun *gobe*, and means "the great head" (potential for an interesting backstory here).

English Variant: Gobenje (GO-ben-je)

(4) *Chaháwo* (Castithan)

Etymology: Derives from the Castithan noun *chaho*, and means "the great soil".

English Variant: Chahawo (cha-HA-wo) or Chaho (cha-HO)

Indogene:  (Chagaw)

(5) *Chahárayo* (Castithan)

Etymology: Also derives from the Castithan noun *chaho*, and means "the great soil" (a different augmentative suffix).

English Variant: Chahare (cha-HA-re) or Chahar (cha-HAR)

Indogene:  (Chagar)

(6) *Daribolo* (Castithan)

Etymology: Derives from the Castithan adjective *dare*, and means "the great expanse".

English Variant: Daribo (DA-ri-bo)

Castithan: දාරිබො



Indogene: (Daribo)

(7) *Darizwo* (Castithan)

Etymology: Also derives from the Castithan adjective *dare*, and means "the hallowed expanse".

English Variant: Darizu (DA-ri-zu) or Darizwo (DA-ri-zwo)

Castithan: දාරිසු



Indogene: (Darizu)

(8) *Dyehibolo* (Castithan)

Etymology: Derives from the Castithan noun *dyevyo*, and means "the great womb".

English Variant: Jehibo (JE-hi-bo)

Castithan: දීඩ්බො



Indogene: (Divibo)

(9) *Nevilano* (Castithan)

Etymology: Derives from the Castithan verb *neviliu*, and means "the giver".

English Variant: Nevila (NE-vi-la)

Indogene:  (Nayfila)

(10) *Yenilino* (Castithan)

Etymology: Derives from the Castithan noun *yenu*, and means "the grower".

English Variant: Yenili (YE-ni-li)

Castithan: 

Indogene:  (Linili)

(11) *Farubo* (Castithan)

Etymology: Derives from the Castithan noun *rubo*, and means "the hallowed seed".

English Variant: Farubo (FA-ru-bo)
